


Wall-Mounted Stainless Steel Solar Light

MODEL PatioPal-SM-StainlessSteel-A: Assembly & Installation Instructions



1. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Pull out the battery box and turn the switch to the “ON” position
- 2) Re-insert the battery box
- 3) Affix the light fixture to the wall

2. FUNCTION & SPECIFICATIONS

1. Durable, great looking stainless steel body
2. No need for wiring – the solar panel charges during the day and the light functions automatically at night
3. Operates for 8-10 hours per night – even charges on partially cloudy days
4. Turns ON automatically at night and OFF automatically in the morning to charge
5. No electric costs (100% free solar powered)
6. Perfect for walkways, driveways, patios, decks, entryways, exits and more

2. LIGHTING TIME

The typical lighting time is between 8-10 hours after a full sunny day (though this will depend on location, season and weather). Lighting time will be longer after sunny and summer (long) days than after cloudy or winter (short) days. To maximize charging, you should clean the solar panel with a neutral solvent and wet cloth from time-to-time.

3. PROBLEM SOLVING



If your light does not work, or is working fewer hours at night, there are several possible problems and solutions:

1. If the solar panel becomes dirty, you should clean it with a neutral solvent and wet cloth. This will usually help the batteries charge better and improve performance.
2. The light should be installed in a location where sunlight can reach it for several hours a day (any shading will affect performance)
3. Ensure that the power switch is in the ON position
4. Move the power switch back forth between ON and OFF several times

4. ATTENTION

1. Be sure to install your light in a sunny location so that it is not shaded during the day
2. Be sure that the power switch is in the ON position
3. Be sure that nothing is covering or obstructing the top solar panel
4. This is not a child's toy

5. REPLACING THE BATTERY

The batteries are standard 600mAh Ni-MH rechargeable battery. The lifetime is around one year under normal conditions. The battery needs to be changed when the light is very dim within 4 hours of turning on after a full sunny day of charging.



IMPORTANT

Your solar garden light will need to be charged in full sunlight for 36-48 hours before the first time it is used.
